




Biology New England South BioNES Registered Participants

The 3rd BioNESUR meeting had **200** participants from 7 institutions: Roger Williams University, University of Massachusetts-Dartmouth, Brown University, Providence College, University of Rhode Island, Salve Regina University, and Rhode Island College. We had 34 Faculty and 166 students. Dr. Kenneth R. Miller from Brown University gave the Keynote Address: *Darwin, God and Design: America's Continuing Problem with Evolution.*

The **BioNES 2008 Graduate Student Award** was given to Aaron Socha from the University of Rhode Island and **BioNES 2008 Undergraduate Student Award** was given to Breton Roussel from Providence College. Six students received poster awards.
